Md. Awesh Alam and another vs Bibi Anisha

Under section 281 of Muslim Law

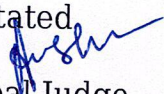
O R D E R

25.03.2026. The present petition had been filed by Md. Awesh Alam, S/o Md. Washiqur Rahman, District Araria on 04.12.2025 for restoration of his conjugal rights with Bibi Anisha Khatoon under section 281 of Mohammedan law. The petitioner claims that he had married with respondent (Bibi Anisha Khatoon) recently from the date of filing of present petitioner according to Islamic rites and customs. Petitioner has filed a document showing prima faice proof of his marriage with respondent. This petition is at the stage of petitioner appearance.

By perusal of proceedings held on previous dates it reveals that the petitioner is not doing his pairvi in this case since 05.07.2025. Today, neither the petitioner nor it's authorized representative has appeared before court. In fact, the petitioner has never appeared before the court after 05.07.2025. The continuous and prolonged absence of petitioner shows that the petitioner is not interested in the outcome of present petition. In absence of pairvi by petitioner itself this court is unable to determine whether any decree regarding restitution of conjugal rights as per prayer made is petition can be granted.

Accordingly, the case is disposed off in view of above observation by the court.
