Dated <u>26.04.2025</u>	The regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused persons/petitioners namely 1. Sarwar Quraishi and 2. Anwar Quraishi who are in judicial custody since 30.09.2024, after serving the copy of the bail petition to the Public Prosecutor and same has been pressed today. The learned counsel for the accused persons/petitioners has submitted that the accused persons/petitioners were on bail. He further submitted that on dated 30.09.2024, the regular bail petition of the petitioners was filed before this court on the cancellation of bail bond of dated 23.07.2024 which was rejected on 05.02.2025 with direction to the prosecution to produce the remaining witnesses at earliest, after refusal of said bail prayer, they have not preferred the bail application before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. He also submitted that since judicial custody, witnesses have been examined but none supported the case of prosecution and the prosecution is failed to adduce the informant and other witnesses and the conclusion of the trial will take much amount of time because the prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined. He also submitted that there is no earning male member in their family, thereby other family members are on starvation and they have been languishing in jail about six months, their lathes have been sufficiently punished. He has prayed to allow him on solvent sureties and has prayed to extend the privileges of bail to the petitioner. At the other hand, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer for bail and has prayed to reject it. After giving due attention to the averments of the both sides, it appears from the record that the bail bonds of the accused persons/petitioners was cancelled on 23.07.2024 and the prayer of bail was rejected on 05.02.2025 with liberty to renew the bail after elapsation of six months. Hence, considering the period of custody since 30.09.2024 and the liberty to prayer for bail of the accused persons/petitioners is provisionally allowed, as a warning chance, the accused persons/petitioners is to be released on furnishing bail bonds of worth Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each with further condition under Section 437 (3) of the Code of Criminal Code, 1973 and accused persons/petitioners will be present in persons on each and every till disposal.
