ORDER DATED 16.03.2026

The instant Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed by (1) Tanveer Alam S/O Idrish Alam, age-25 years, (2) Reshma Khatoon, W/O Tauqir Alam, Age-28 years Both R/O village-Sinduari, PS- Phesar, District- Aurangabad (Bihar) arising out of Complaint Case no. 763/2024 pending in the court of Sri Subhankar Shukla Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Aurangabad under Section 85, 3(5) of the BNS.

Sri Vinod Kumar Pandey, learned counsel on behalf of the petitioners stated that petitioners were innocent as petitioner no.1 who was husband of the complainant was ready to keep her but she was refusing. Earlier, in a mediation case no. 33/2025 the parties entered into compromise but the complainant resisted to go to her matrimonial house. The complainant has alleged the petitioner no.1 had illicit relationship with petitioner no.2 which was false and baseless because petitioner no.2 was married to brother of petitioner no.1 and was residing with her husband in Delhi. In light of given facts, the learned Counsel prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

The learned A.P.P. Sri Irshad Alam vehemently opposed the anticipatory bail petition on the ground that the allegations imposed against the petitioners were heinous in nature.

Heard both the sides and perused the case record.

On perusal of case record it is revealed that this case has been registered under Sections 85, 3(5) of the BNS. The allegation against the petitioners is that they along with other accused persons subjected her to physical and mental cruelty for dowry demand. Perusal of the case record reveals that the petitioner no.1 was the husband of the complainant while petitioner no.2 was her co-sister (Gotini). According to the complaint petition the cause of tensed relationship between the complainant and petitioner no.1 was illicit relationship between both the petitioners. Considering the seriousness of allegation imposed upon the petitioners Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners Tanveer Alam and Reshma Khatoon is hereby **rejected**.
