Apprehending their arrest in connection with Barun P.S. Case No.27/2026 instituted for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioners have moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The brief facts of the case of the prosecution are that on 13.01.2026 at about 03:00PM, all accused persons including the petitioners have assaulted the wife of informant named as Gulabi Devi in which she sustained injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioners are quite innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. He further stated that there is a counter case between the parties. Petitioner is having no criminal antecedent. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

There is an allegation against accused persons including the petitioners that they have assaulted the wife of informant and caused injury. From perusal of an FIR as well as case diary, it appears that there is a general and omnibus allegations against the petitioners. From perusal of injury report it appears that all injuries are found to be simple in nature except injury no.2 which is found grievous. The injury no.2 was caused over left hand of Gulabo Devi by hard and blunt substance. There is a case and counter case between the parties. It is mentioned at para 20 of the case that petitioners are having clean antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts that there is case and counter case between the parties and the petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. Hence, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the above-named petitioners, is hereby allowed. It is directed to release the petitioners on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount by each of petitioners subject to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
