Apprehending their arrest in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No.477/2025 instituted for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 303(2), 109(1), 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioners have moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the Id. P.P. for the State.

The briefly stated prosecution story is that on 23.12.2025 at about 10:00AM, the informant was at her home, at the same time accused persons including the petitioners came at her home and abused her. When she objected for the same, then they assaulted her. When her son named as Vikas Kumar came to rescue her, then accused persons also assaulted her son in which he sustained injury over his head. It is also alleged that Kedar Yadav has snatched her golden jitya from her neck and also snatched a chain from her son.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners that the petitioners are wholly innocent and have committed no offence. He further stated that a case has been filed by the mother of petitioner named as

Yashomati Devi against the son of informant vide Mufassil P.S. case No.480/2025 and to escape from this case, the informant has filed the present case. Petitioner is having no criminal antecedent. It is therefore prayed that the petitioners be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned P.P. for the State.

It is alleged against the four accused persons including the petitioners that they had abused and beaten to the informant. When her son came to intervene, he was beaten by the Petitioner No.1 and 3 by lathi and stick by which Vikas Kumar got a head injury. The present anticipatory bail petition was filed on dated 29.01.2026 and on dated 30.01.2026, the court was pleased to call for case diary along with criminal antecedents but case diary has been submitted without any injury report and a copy of the injury dated 15.01.2026 shows that Vikas Kumar was examined and there was lacerated wound in left parietal area, 3cm x ½ skin deep was found over his body and he was advised for X-ray skull and NCCT Brain but till now patient has not deposited X-ray/NCCT. The present anticipatory bail petition has been kept pending till receiving of supplementary injury report but there is no supplementary injury report supplied till date and in the absence of report of X-ray and NCCT, the opinion is kept reserved. There is a case and counter case between the parties. It is mentioned at para 3 of the anticipatory bail petition that petitioners are having no criminal antecedents.

Considering the fact that there was no repetition of blow over the body of the injured, there is a case and counter case between the parties, petitioners and informant are co-villagers and petitioners are having clean antecedent. Hence, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the above-named petitioners, is hereby allowed. It is directed to release the petitioners on bail in the
