Apprehending his arrest in connection with Rafiganj P.S. Case No.113/2025 instituted for the offence u/s 319(1), 318(4) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioner has moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The briefly stated prosecution story is that Block Development Officer, Rafiganj who has filed a written report before officer in-Charge for lodging an FIR stating in the light of the letter Number 378/DGD dated 07.03.2025 that an order has been received to register an FIR against the petitioners. Through the relevant letter, District Officer received a compliant from Chandan Kumar, only the names of those people who were to give Rs.3,000/-, as informed by the people of Mukhiya and Housing Assistant, are being included in the housing list. Thereafter, the concerned complaint was investigated. In the investigation report, The Gram Panchayat Baur, on the charge of demanding illegal money in the ongoing survey work for adding illegal new families under PMAYG by the accused persons including the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case.

He further stated petitioner is posted as Panchayat Housing Assistant. Co-accused has already been granted bail by this court vide ABP No.574/2025 on dated 26.06.2025. Petitioner is having no criminal antecedent. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State. Ld.P.P. submits before the court that there is no serious allegation has been made out against the petitioner and nothing has been come out in the case diary.

Considering the submission on behalf of the petitioner and the Ld.P.P., who fairly submits before the court that no serious allegation has been attributed towards the petitioner. Hence, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the above-named petitioner, is hereby allowed. It is directed to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount subject to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
