Apprehending their arrest in connection with Obra P.S. Case No. 05/2026 instituted under Section 115(2), 126(2), 117(2), 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioners have moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon Ld. P.P. for the state.

The brief facts of the case are that petitioner no. 2 assaulted to the informant by a sword causing injury over his right while petitioner no. 1 assaulted to hi by an iron rod causing injury on his right leg. It is further alleged that petitioner no. 2 assaulted to the son of informant with stick.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing has been happened as alleged in the FIR. Injury was found to be simple in nature. It is further submitted that a complaint case bearing no. 04/2026 has been filed by the side of the petitioner against the informant. Both the parties are family members. Petitioners are having no criminal antecedent except petitioner no 1, who is accused in Obra P.S. Case No. 101/2009. On these grounds, it is prayed that the petitioners be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and learned P.P. for the State.

As per F.I.R., it is alleged against the petitioners caused caused injury to the informant and his son. From perusal of injury report it appears that the injury sustained by the injured Shankar Ram was found to be simple in nature. Injury report of the son of informant is not attached with the case diary. The informant and the petitioners are brothers and sister and there is family dispute going on between them. There is case and counter case between the parties.

Considering the nature of injury and the fact that both the parties are family members and there is case and counter case between them. Hence, **the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners is hereby allowed.** It is directed to release the petitioners on bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
