ORDER DATED 19.03.2026

The instant Bail Petition has been filed by (1) Md. Alam Ansari @ Md. Alamgir, Age- 35 years, S/O Mokin Ansari, R/o- village- Masihani, P.S.- Chhatarpur, District- Palamu (Jharkhand) arising out of Nabinagar P.S. Case No. 07/2016 pending in the court of learned SDJM, Aurangabad under Sections 498(A), 341, 323 and 504 of the IPC and S. 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act. The petitioner is in custody since 12.02.2026.

Md. Akmal Hassan, the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner stated that earlier anticipatory bail petition was filed before the present Court and the Hon'ble High Court, Patna but the same was rejected. Petitioner had clean antecedent and had falsely been implicated in the present case as he never demanded any dowry from the daughter of the informant. Instead, she left matrimonial house on her own accord and renounced all the marital ties with the petitioner. The petitioner due to poverty could not appear before the Court of learned SDJM, Aurangabad and subsequently the mentioned Court declared him absconder. In light of given facts, the learned Counsel prayed to grant bail to the petitioner.

The learned A.P.P. vehemently opposed the bail petition on the ground that the allegation imposed against the petitioner was serious in nature.

Heard and perused the case record.

On perusal of case record it is revealed that the cognizance in the present case has been taken under Sections 498(A), 341, 323, 504, 174(A) and 34 of the IPC and S. 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act. The prosecution story in short is that the petitioner got married with Noorjahan Khatoun daughter of the informant in the year 2014. In her matrimonial house the Noorjahan Khatoun was body shamed and was subjected to physical and mental cruelty for dowry demand and was ousted from her matrimonial house after few months of marriage. Perusal of the case record reveals that notice was issued on Noorjahan Khatoun by the present Court for the purpose of referring the matter for mediation but she did not appear before the present Court.

Further, the petitioner is in custody since 12.02.2026. Therefore, considering the period of detention of the petitioner the Court is to the conclusion that the petitioner deserves the privilege of bail, on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of SDJM, Aurangabad. Accordingly the regular bail petition of the petitioner Md. Alam Ansari @ Md. Alamgir is hereby **allowed**.
