Apprehending their arrest in connection with Daudnagar P.S. Case No.96/2026 instituted for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 351(2), 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioners have moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

It is the case of the prosecution that on 25.01.2026 at about 06:30PM, all the petitioners, armed with lathi, danda, have assaulted the informant in which he sustained arm injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. There is a counter case vide Daudnagar P.S case no.19/2026 which is lodged by the side of petitioner- Kusum Devi against the informant and his family members and to escape from this case, informant has filed the present case. Petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

There is an allegation that the petitioners, being armed with lathi and danda, assaulted the informant causing injury. From perusal of record, it appears that there are general and omnibus allegations against the petitioners. From perusal of the injury report, the injuries sustained are found to be simple in nature and caused on non-vital parts of the body. There is a case and counter case between the parties. It is also mentioned at paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioners are having no criminal antecedent.

Considering the fact that there are general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners, injuries are found to be simple in nature. Hence, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the above-named petitioners, is hereby allowed. It is directed to release the petitioners on bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount by each of petitioners subject to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
