ORDER DATED 18.03.2026

The instant Bail Petition has been filed by (1) Sanjay Yadav, Age- 37 years, S/O Late Suresh Yadav, (2) Ranjan Yadav, Age-23 years, S/O Parshuram Yadav Both R/o- village- Jakhaura, P.S.- Haspura, District- Aurangabad (Bihar) arising out of Haspura P.S. Case No. 111/2024 pending in the court of Sri Ashish Kumar, Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Daudnagar under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 427, 504 and 506 of the IPC. The petitioners are in custody since 20.01.2026

Sri Shyam Sundar Sharma, the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioners stated that earlier anticipatory bail petition was filed before the present Court and the Hon'be High Court, Patna but the same was rejected. Petitioners had clean antecedent and had falsely been implicated in the present case only because of the land dispute between the parties. Hence, the learned Counsel prayed to grant bail to the petitioner.

The learned A.P.P. Sri Irshad Alam vehemently opposed the bail petition on the ground that the allegation imposed against the petitioner was serious in nature.

Heard and perused the case record.

On perusal of case record it is revealed that this case has been lodged under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 427, 504 and 506 of the IPC. The allegation against the petitioners is that Sanjay Yadav (Petitioner no.1) caught hold of the husband of the informant while Petitioner no.2 (Ranjan Yadav) and another co-accused gave gadasa and axe blow on his head. According to the CT scan of the injured he had multiple fractures on his skull and his injury report depict that he had lacerated wound on forehead, left eyebrow and right zygomatic of the cheek area. The above mentioned injuries are on head and face which are on the vital part of the body coupled with the fact that the alleged injuries were caused by gadasa and axe clearly indicating that the intention of the petitioners were to murder the injured. Although, the petitioners are in custody since 20.01.2026 but considering the seriousness of allegation imposed upon them the Court is not inclined to release them on bail. Accordingly, the bail petition of the petitioner no.1 Sanjay Yadav and petitioner no.2 Ranjan Yadav is hereby **rejected**.
