Apprehending his arrest in connection with Barun P.S. Case No.471/2025 instituted for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioner has moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The briefly stated prosecution story is that on 07.10.2025, at around 09:30 PM, father of the informant was at home. At that time, accused persons, including the petitioner have abused and assaulted to his father and other labours in which her father sustained head injury.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that the petitioner is wholly innocent and has committed no offence. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He further stated that the petitioner is a handicapped person. A counter case has also been registered vide Barun P.S. Case No. 461/2025. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

From perusal of an FIR, it appears that the date of occurrence is on dated 07.10.2025 but the FIR regarding the said occurrence was lodged on 13.10.2025. It is also observed that the petitioner Dwarika Singh had lodged an FIR vide Barun P.S. Case No. 461/2025 against the informant and her family members. During scuffle, both sides had sustained injuries. So far as injury sustained by the injured is concerned, the said injury was found to be simple in nature. Today, there is a petition filed on behalf of the petitioner to the fact that he is handicapped person and he has also sustained injury over his head.

Considering the aforesaid facts and observations, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the above-named petitioner, is hereby allowed. It is directed to release the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount by petitioner subject to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
