Apprehending their arrest in connection with Jamhore P.S. Case No.20/2026 instituted for the offence u/s 331(2), 305, 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioners have moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The briefly stated prosecution story is that on 20.01.2026 at about 10:30PM, all the named accused persons have entered into the house of the informant and stolen Rs.1.20 Lakh from his house.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners that the petitioners are wholly innocent and have committed no offence. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case due to village politics. He further stated that land dispute is going on between the parties. A counter case has also been registered vide Jamhore P.S. Case No. 21/2026 and to escape from this case, informant has filed the present case. Petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. It is therefore prayed that the petitioners be enlarged on anticipatory

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned P.P. for the State.

It is alleged against the petitioners that they had entered into the house of the informant and stolen Rs.1.20 Lakh from his house. It is admitted fact that petitioners and informant are known to each other. Since the petitioners are resident of adjoining village and there is a counter FIR vide Jamhore P.S. Case No. 21/2026 is registered by Petitioner No.2-Kundan Kumar against the informant and his family members. Para 31 of the case diary, it is mentioned about the fact that petitioners are having no criminal antecedent.

Considering the nature of offence and the facts that there is a case and counter case between the parties and petitioners are having clean antecedent. Hence, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the above-named petitioners, is hereby allowed. It is directed to release the petitioners on bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount by each petitioners subject to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
