Apprehending their arrest in connection with Khudwan P.S. Case No.92/2023 instituted for the offence u/s 147, 149, 447, 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 379, 504, 506/34 of Indian Penal Code, petitioners have moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The briefly stated prosecution story is that on 03.11.2023 at about 05:20PM, all the named accused persons armed with Lathi, iron rod and sharp cut weapon, have abused and assaulted the informant. Petitioner-Rohit Kumar has assaulted the informant by iron rod in which he sustained hand injury. It is also alleged that Anand Kumar and Shiv Pukar have also assaulted to the nephew of the informant in which his nephew sustained arm injury and Anand Kumar has snatched Rs.5000/- and a golden chain from his nephew.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners that the petitioners are wholly innocent and have committed no offence. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. He further stated that a counter case has also been registered vide Khudwan P.S. Case No. 93/2023. Petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. It is therefore prayed that the petitioners be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned P.P. for the State.

From perusal of an FIR and the document attached herewith and the LCR attached with record, it appears that there is a case and counter case between the parties. The informant has lodged an FIR vide Khudwan P.S. case No.92/2023 against the petitioners and on the other hand, there is another FIR lodged against the informant and his other members vide Khudwan P.S case No. 93/2023. Injury sustained by the side of the informant are found to be simple in nature. After investigation, the charge-sheet was submitted against the accused persons named as Saurabh Kumar @ Bhiko and Ramkishore Sharma for an offence under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 504, 506 r/w Section 34 of IPC and the accused persons named as Rohit Kumar, Aanad Kumar, Shiv Pukar @ Pandey, Ramgovind Sharma and Amrit Kumar were not sent up. However, learned Magistrate has taken cognizance vide order dated 20.02.2024 for an offence under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 379, 504, 506 r/w Section 34 of IPC and issued processes against all seven accused persons.

Considering the fact that petitioners and informant are co-villagers, there is a case and counter case between the parties, injuries were found to be simple in nature. Hence, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the above-named petitioners, is hereby **allowed**. It is directed to release the petitioners on bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a
