The petitioners, who have been undergoing judicial custody since 18.02.2026, preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Haspura P.S. Case No.73/2025 instituted for the offence u/s 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 132, 121(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State

The briefly stated prosecution story is that on 16.03.2025 at 16:30 hours when the informant along with other police personnel was on patrolling duty, he received an information that two sides were fighting against each other in village Chanhat. Acting on the said tip-off, he along with other police personnel reached the spot. When the informant tried to intervene, the named accused persons including the petitioner and other unknown persons attacked them with lathi and danda, as a result of which Home Guard Chandilal Singh received injury over his head while another Guard Ajay Kumar received injury over his back.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners that the petitioners are an innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. He further stated that due to personal enmity, local chowkidar, has mentioned the name of the petitioners in the FIR. It is further submitted that the

petitioners are doing labour work and stays outside of village. Petitioners are having one criminal antecedents. On these grounds, it is prayed that the petitioners be given the privileges of bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioners.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

As per allegation, accused persons had abused and caused injury to the police party, who had gone at the place of spot to pacify the persons who were involved in abusing to another community. Fourteen persons have been made an accused in this case including the petitioners named as Jeetan Paswan and Lakshman Paswan. The name of the petitioners had been implicated on the basis of statement given by a local chowkidar present at the place of spot. Both petitioners have been undergoing judicial custody in the present case since 18.02.2026. It is mentioned at para 3 of the petition that petitioners are having one criminal antecedent vide Haspura P.S. Case No.77/2025 in which they are on bail.

Considering the fact that there is general and omnibus allegations against the petitioners and they have been undergoing judicial custody, hence, bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners is hereby **allowed** subject to furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
