The petitioner, who has been undergoing judicial custody since 07.02.2026, preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Obra P.S. Case No.43/2026 instituted for the offence u/s 115(2), 126(2), 117(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the Id. P.P. for the State.

The brief facts of the prosecution case is that on dated 06.02.2026 when the informant was going to market, in the meantime, accused person including the petitioner have assaulted the informant in which he sustained head and lip injury. It is also alleged that accused persons have stolen his golden chain. When his brother came to rescue him, then accused persons have also assaulted to his brother in which his brother sustained head injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He further stated that informant and petitioner are close neighbour and there is a dispute over the drainage of water. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody since 07.02.2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be released on bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

Both petitioner and the informant are resident of same locality and it is alleged that during the fight, the informant sustained injury over his head and lips. It is further alleged that the accused persons had stolen a golden chain and further injured to the brother of informant named as Bittu kumar. However, from perusal of injury report, it is found that injury received by the informant, was found to be grievous. So far as the other injured person is concerned, his injury was found to be simple. The theft of golden chain appears to be ornamental in nature. It is mentioned in the injury report of the informant that fracture of nasal bone of right side was observed due to which his injury was found to be grievous.

Considering the fact that petitioner has been undergoing judicial custody since 07.02.2026 and having clean antecedent and there was no premeditation on the part of the petitioner. Hence, bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner is hereby **allowed** subject to furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
