Apprehending their arrest in connection with Deo P.S. Case No. 26 of 2026 instituted under Sections 190, 191(2), 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioners have moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The brief facts of the case are that during the procession of Saraswati Puja, obscene and vulgar songs were being played by the accused persons and on objection being raised, the accused persons including the petitioners assaulted to the informant side by lathi, danda and bricks and caused injuries to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and they have not committed any offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No specific allegation of assault has been attributed against the petitioners. The present case is the counter blast of Deo P.S. Case No. 27/2026. All other sections are bailable in nature except Section 109 BNS. Petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. It is therefore prayed that the petitioners be released on anticipatory bail.

Per contra, learned P.P. opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and learned P.P. for the State.

appears that both sides have made scuffle against other party. There are general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. At para-47 of the case diary, it is mentioned that petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. At para-88 of the case diary, it is mentioned that the injury caused to all injured persons are found to be simple in nature and caused by hard and blunt substance. It also appears that there is counter case lodged by the side of the petitioner vide Deo P.S. Case No. 27/2026.

Considering the fact that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners, there is case and counter case between the parties, injuries are found to be simple in nature and the petitioners are having clean antecedent. **Hence, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners Parmod Singh and Yogendra Singh is hereby allowed.** Petitioners are directed to be released on bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount by each petitioners to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
