Apprehending his arrest in connection with Deo P.S. Case No. 28 of 2026 instituted under Sections 303(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioner has moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

An FIR against unknown has been lodged by the informant alleging therein that she had parked her motorcycle bearing Registration No. JH 10AT 2751 in front of her house from where it got missing on 26.01.2026.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner has been surfaced out in the confessional statement of co-accused Ranjit Kumar. It is further submitted that the alleged stolen motorcycle has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is having no criminal antecedent. It is therefore prayed that the petitioners be released on anticipatory bail.

Per contra, learned P.P. opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and learned P.P. for the State.

From perusal of para-29 of the case diary, it appears that the stolen motorcycle has been recovered from a public place. It is mentioned at para-22 of the case diary that one person, who has been arrested by the police, however, later he was declared juvenile, made confessional statement and on the basis of the said

confessional statement name of the petitioner has been implicated in the present case. At para-25 of the case diary, it is mentioned that petitioner is having clean antecedent.

Considering the fact that the stolen motorcycle was not recovered from the possession of the petitioner, his name has been implicated on the basis of confessional statement of another person and he is having clean antecedent. **Hence, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner Vishal Kumar is hereby allowed.** It is directed to release the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
