The petitioners, who have been undergoing judicial custody since 20.01.2026, preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Goh P.S. Case No.19/2026 instituted for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(1), 117(1), 109, 352, 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The brief facts of the prosecution is that on 19.01.2026 at about 07:00PM all accused persons including the petitioners have assaulted the informant and his family members in which he sustained head and arm injury. It is also alleged that his brother has also sustained head injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody since 20.01.2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioners be released on bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

There is an allegation against the accused persons including the petitioners that they have assaulted the informant, his wife and his brother and caused injury to them. From perusal of an injury report dated 09.02.2026, all injuries are found to be simple in nature. There is no specific allegations against the petitioners. It is mentioned at para 28 of the case diary that petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. Petitioners have been undergoing judicial custody since 20.01.2026.

Considering the fact that no specific allegation against the petitioners, injuries were found to be simple in nature and petitioner have been undergoing judicial custody last two months. Hence, bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners is hereby **allowed** subject to furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
