Apprehending their arrest in connection with Tandwa P.S. Case No. 26/2026 instituted under Section 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioners have moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon Ld. P.P. for the state.

The brief facts of the case are that the accused persons abused and beaten to the informant by an iron rod and caused injury over his head.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case as they have not committed any offence as alleged in the F.I.R. The present case is the counter blast of Tandwa P.S. Case No. 25/2026. No specific allegation of assault has been attributed to the petitioners. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that compromise has been taken place between the parties. Petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. It is therefore prayed that the petitioners be released on anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for the prosecution also submits that compromise has been arrived between the parties and they have amicably settled their dispute.

Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, learned counsel for the informant and learned P.P. for the State.

At para-50 of the case diary, it is mentioned that the informant-cum-injured Golu Kumar had undergone medical treatment at Referral Hospital, Nabinagar but he was not approached to Sadar Hospital, Aurangabad for his further treatment and there was no CT Scan made of the injured and due to non-availability of CT Scan report, nature of injury is kept reserved. In the meantime, both parties have approached for compromise with one another and compromise petition has been filed bearing the signature of the informant and the accused persons including the petitioner.

Considering the fact that compromise has been made between the parties and the injured had not undergone for any further treatment at Sadar Hospital, Aurangabad and harmony has been made between them. It is also mentioned at para-27 of the case diary that the petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. Hence, **the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the above named petitioners is hereby allowed.** It is directed to release the petitioners on bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
