The petitioners, who have been undergoing judicial custody since 28.02.2026, preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Tandwa P.S. Case No.12/2026 instituted for the offence u/s 115(2), 117(2), 126(2), 109(1) and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the Id. P.P. for the State.

The brief facts of the prosecution is that on 16.02.2026 at about 10:00PM, when the informant was sleeping at his field, all accused persons including the petitioners came and abused him. When the informant objected, then Durga Bhuiya has assaulted the informant in which he sustained head injury. It is also alleged that Bihari Bhuiya and Badal Kumar have also assaulted to the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent. He further stated that as a matter of fact that informant has assaulted to the family members of petitioners for which a criminal case before the SC/ST Police, has been lodged. It is lastly submitted that the petitioners have been languishing under judicial custody since 28.02.2026. It is therefore prayed that the

petitioners be released on bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioners.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

There is an allegation against accused persons including the petitioners that they have assaulted to the informant and caused head injury. From perusal of case diary as well as injury report it appears that all injuries are found to be simple in nature. It is mentioned at para 36 of the case diary that petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. Petitioners have been undergoing judicial custody since 28.02.2026.

Considering the fact that injuries were found to be simple in nature, petitioners are having clean antecedent and petitioners have been undergoing judicial custody since 28.02.2026. Hence, bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners is hereby **allowed** subject to furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
