The petitioners, who have been undergoing judicial custody since 08.02.2026, preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Aurangabad (Town) P.S. Case No.106/2026 instituted for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1)/ 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the Id. P.P. for the State.

The brief facts of the prosecution is that on 06.02.2026 at about 10:00PM, the husband of the informant came at her house and abused her, when she objected, her husband has assaulted her. When her nephew came to rescue her, petitioner has also assaulted him. On 07.02.2026 at about 12:00PM, again her husband and her son abused and assaulted her in which she sustained head injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioners have submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent. Petitioner No.1 is husband of informant and petitioner No.2 is son of the informant and the present FIR has been registered due to domestic dispute. It is lastly submitted that the petitioners have been languishing under judicial custody since 08.02.2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioners be released on bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

Petitioner No.1 is husband and Petitioner No.2 is son of the informant. It is alleged by the informant that they had abused and caused injury to her in which she has sustained head injury and regarding the aforesaid allegation, the petitioners have been arrested and undergoing judicial custody since 08.02.2026. The informant present in-person before the court and she states that there was domestic issue which resulted into beating to the informant. However, she wants to settle the matter with her husband and son. It is specifically stated by the informant regarding her son that he had not caused any injury to her.

Considering the fact that there is a family dispute between the parties, petitioner no.1 &2 are the husband and the son of the informant and informant herself wants to compromise the matter. Hence bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners is hereby **allowed** subject to furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
