The petitioner, who has been undergoing judicial custody since 03.02.2026, preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Aurangabad (Town) P.S. Case No.53/2007 instituted for the offence u/s 448, 323/34 of Indian Penal Code. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The brief facts of the prosecution is that on dated 21.03.2007 at about 12:00PM, accused persons including the petitioner were throwing bricks and stones at the house of the informant. When the informant objected then accused persons including petitioner have assaulted the informant and his family members, causing injuries to their hands and legs.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He further stated that co-accused has also granted bail on dated 03.01.2018. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody since 03.02.2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be released on bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

From perusal of the order as passed by the concerned learned court, it appears that the petitioner has made default in his appearance before the concerned court for the second time. The case is very old one and having been registered in the year 2007 and was placed at the stage of prosecution evidence. Due to non-appearance of the accused persons, the evidence of the prosecution could not be completed. Petitioner has been undergoing judicial custody since 03.02.2026.

Considering the aforesaid observation, bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner is hereby **allowed** subject to furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below. It is further directed that one of the sureties shall be a family member of the petitioner. The petitioner shall also file an undertaking before the concerned court that he will appear on each and every date fixed in the case, and in case he fails to appear on two consecutive dates without any reasonable explanation, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled.
