The petitioners, who have been undergoing judicial custody since 11.02.2026, preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Madanpur P.S. Case No.56/2026 instituted for the offence u/s 191(2), 190, 126(2), 117(1), 109 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The brief facts of the prosecution is that on 09.02.2026 at about 08:00PM, all the accused persons including the petitioners have assaulted to the informant and his father in which his father sustained hand and finger injury. When his brother Vishwajit Kumar came to rescue him, accused persons have also assaulted them in which his brother has also sustained head injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners. He has

further stated that there is a case and counter case vide Madanpur, P.S case no.57/2026 filed by the petitioner against the informant and to escape from this case, informant has filed the present case. It is lastly submitted that the petitioners have been languishing under judicial custody since 11.02.2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioners be released on bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioners.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

The present FIR has been filed against twelve named accused persons including the petitioners that they have assaulted the informant and his father including his family members. From perusal of an injury report it appears that all injuries are found to be simple in nature except injury no.3 of Ramdev Saw whose one injury in his left hand little finger was found to be grievous. No specific allegations have been attributed against the petitioners. There is a case and counter case vide Madanpur P.S case no.57/2026 lodge by the petitioner no.4 against the informant. It is mentioned at para 43 of the case diary that petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. Petitioners have been undergoing judicial custody since 11.02.2026.

Considering the fact that no specific allegation against the petitioners, petitioners are having clean antecedent, case and counter case between the parties and petitioners have been undergoing judicial custody last one monthss. Hence, bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners is hereby **allowed** subject to furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
