Apprehending his arrest in connection with Tandwa P.S. Case No.12/2026 instituted for the offence u/s 115(2), 117(2), 126(2), 109(1), 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioner has moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The brief facts of the prosecution is that on 16.02.2026 at about 10:00PM, when the informant was sleeping at his field, all accused persons including the petitioners came and abused him. When the informant objected, then Durga Bhuiya has assaulted the informant in which he sustained head injury. It is also alleged that Bihari Bhuiya and Badal Kumar have also assaulted to the informant.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that the petitioner is wholly innocent and has committed no offence. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He further stated that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. Petitioner is having no criminal antecedent. It is therefore prayed that the petitioners be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned P.P. for the State.

From perusal of an FIR, it is alleged that the petitioner had caused injury to the informant by lathi. From perusal of an injury report of Janeshwar Mehta, all injuries are found to be simple in nature. It is mentioned at para 3 of the anticipatory bail petition that the petitioner is having clean antecedent. The petitioner had not used any deadly weapon.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the above-named petitioner, is hereby allowed. It is directed to release the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount by each subject to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
