The surrender-cum-bail petition has been filed on behalf of the accused persons/petitioners namely **1. Ranjay Singh and 2. Chhottu @ Vivek Kumar Singh** after serving the copy to the learned Special Public Prosecutor, SC/ST (POA) Act.

The learned counsel for the accused persons/petitioners has submitted that the accused persons/petitioners was enlarged on bail by this court but the bail bond of the petitioners had been cancelled on 29.11.2024 and the bail bonds of the petitioners have been cancelled due to not proper pairvi and petitioner undertakes to be remain present in the Court on each and every date as per order of the Court. He further added that the accused persons/petitioners undertake that it will not be repeated in future and will make their pairvi proper. He has prayed to allow them on solvent sureties and has prayed to extend the privileges of bail to the petitioners/accused persons.

At the other hand, the learned Special public prosecutor has opposed the prayer for bail and has prayed to reject it.

After giving due attention to the averments of the both sides, it appears that it is the case of two dates misuse. From perusal of the case record that both parties have shown keenness to compromise in the matter. Bearing in mind, the basis so shown by the learned counsel for the petitioner, it appears justifiable to extend the privileges of bail thereby by to release them from custody as a warning chance on furnishing bail bonds of worth Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount with a condition that they will be **in attendance till the disposal of this file from one date to another so fixed from time to time from this court** and their failure without any cogent reason will incline this court to cancel their bail bonds. Accordingly, the prayer is **allowed**.
