Apprehending their arrest in connection with Obra P.S. Case No.114/2026 instituted for the offence u/s 115(2), 126(2), 117(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 of Bharitya Nyaya Sanhita, petitioners have moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the Id. P.P. for the State.

The brief prosecution case is that the accused persons including the petitioner had assaulted to the informant by iron rod in which he sustained head injury. When the daughter of informant Sunita Kumari had come to rescue him then accused persons also assaulted her by khanti, causing head injury. It is further alleged that the accused persons also assaulted the maternal grandson of informant named as Sumit Kumar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent. Nothing has happened in the manner as alleged in the FIR. It is further submitted that both the parties are neighbours. Petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. It is therefore prayed that the petitioners be enlarged on

anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned P.P. for the State.

There is no specific allegation against the petitioners. From perusal of injury report it is found that the injuries sustained by Kundan Kumar and Sumit kumar are found to be simple in nature. Although, the injury sustained by Sunita Kumari is found to be grievous in nature. It is admitted position that there is a land dispute between the parties. It is mentioned at para 3 of the anticipatory bail petition that petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. Earlier, the anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of petitioner Binay Ram @ Binod Ram was withdrawn by the learned counsel. Accordingly, no order is being passed in respect of the said petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid observation, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners is hereby **allowed**. It is directed to release the petitioners named as Fulkeshari Devi and Shilamuni Devi on bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
