The petitioner, who has been undergoing judicial custody since dated 18.04.2026, preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Haspura P.S. Case No. 116 of 2026 instituted under Sections 103(1), 308(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

An F.I.R. has been lodged by the informant wherein he alleged that on dated 09.04.2026, his younger brother Aman Kumar @ Maan Singh had brutally assaulted to his father Rameshwar Singh as a result of whih he sustained severe injury. The informant took his father to Trauma Centre, Varanasi where during course of treatment, the informant’s father was died.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and he has been falsely implicated. Nothing has been happened as alleged in the F.I.R. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is completely false and fabricated. Petitioner is having no criminal antecedent. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody since dated 18.04.2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be released on bail.

Per contra, learned P.P. opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

As per F.I.R., the petitioner had caused injury to his father which led to his death. From perusal of postmortem report, it is found that the cause of death of deceased is head injury and blood loss. The petitioner has confessed his guilt before the police during course of investigation and in this regard, his confessional

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statement has been recorded.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has committed heinous offence and he had caused injury to his father which ultimately led to his death. Hence, the bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner Aman Kumar @ Maan Singh is hereby rejected.
