Apprehending their arrest in connection with Goh P.S. Case No. 119/2026 instituted under Section 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 74, 303(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioners have moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon Ld. P.P. for the state.

The brief facts of the case are that the petitioners had beaten to the informant and his persons by lathi, danda and other weapons as a result of which the informant had sustained injury over his head, Rudresh Kumar had sustained injury over his leg, Meghnath Kumar has sustained injury over his left hand. It is further alleged that the petitioners had entered into the house of informant and outraged the modesty of female members and beaten to them.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence.

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No specific allegation has been attributed against the petitioners. Present case is the counter blast of Goh P.S. Case No. 118/2026. Sections 109(1), 74, 303(2) of BNS have been levelled only to make the case non-bailable. Petitioners are having one criminal antecedent. On these grounds, it is prayed that the petitioners be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and learned P.P. for the State.

As per allegation, the petitioners had caused head injury to the informant and two other persons and it is further alleged that they had outraged the modesty of female members. It is mentioned at para-13 of the case diary that the petitioner no. 2 is having one criminal antecedent and other petitioners are having clean antecedent. The present FIR is the counter blast of Goh P.S. Case No. 118/2026. It is further mentioned at para-34 of the case diary, which is supervision report that both sides had entered into scuffle and caused injury to one another. So far as injury details of the injured persons are concerned, all injured had sustained injuries which are found to be simple in nature.

Considering the aforesaid observation, **the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of above named six petitioners is hereby allowed.** It is directed to release the petitioners on bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount by each subject to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
