Apprehending their arrest in connection with Kutumba P.S. Case No. 52 of 2026 instituted under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioners have moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The briefly stated prosecution story is that the accused persons including the petitioners armed with pistol, sword, khanti and iron rod had entered into the house and caused injury to the informant. It is further alleged that the accused persons had assaulted to the younger sister-in-law of informant one Sanjit Kumar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have been falsely implicated in the present case. Nothing as been happened as alleged in the F.I.R. The present case is the counter blast of Kutumba P.S. Case No. 74/2026. Petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. It is lastly submitted that co-accused Vinod Ram has been released on bail by this court

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vide B.P. No. 567/2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioners be released on anticipatory bail.

Per contra, learned P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and learned P.P. for the State.

It is alleged against the petitioners that they caused injury to the informant and family members. There is specific allegation against the petitioner no. 1 Dhirendra Ram and one co-accused Vinod Ram that they had caused head injury to the informant. **The anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of petitioner no. 1 Dhirendra Ram has been withdrawn on last date by the learned counsel. Hence, no order is passed against petitioner no. 1.** Both persons named as Dhirendra Ram and Vinod Ram is no longer petitioners in this case. The informant Arjun Paswan had received lacerated wound over his head, which was found to be grievous.

Considering the fact that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner no. 2 to 5 and they are having clean antecedent, as mentioned at para-3 of the anticipatory bail petition. **Hence, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner nos. 2, 3, 4 and 5 namely Pawan Ram, Ashok Ram, Shivkumar Ram and Ramesh Ram is hereby allowed.** It is directed to release the petitioner nos. 2 to 5 on bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount by each subject to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
