The petitioner, who has been undergoing judicial custody since dated 09.03.2026, preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Aurangabad (Town) P.S. Case No. 93 of 2026 instituted under Sections u/s 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the Id. P.P. for the State.

The brief facts of the case are that on dated 03.02.2026 at about 05:30 hours, the informant received information that the accused persons involved in Town P.S. Case No. 90/2026 are preparing to flee another State. Acting on the said information, the informant along with other police personnel reached at a Farm under the four-lane overbridge. On seeing the police party, three persons who were standing there, started fleeing away. However, they were apprehended by the police and on inquiry, they disclosed their name as Md. Danish, Md. Ragib and Farhan Khan. All these three arrested persons were brought to police station and their confessional statements were recorded. In their confessional statement they disclosed that they had played a key role in the murder of Md. Junaid by shooters Shahjad Hussain @ Mister and Md. Faij. As per the disclosure made by Md. Danish, one country made pistol, two automatic pistols, six magazines, one hundred twenty-three live cartridges of K.F. 7.65 pistol, six live cartridges of 0.315 bore and two mobile phones were recovered from his house. As per the disclosure of Md. Danish, one of the shooters named as Shahjad Hussain @ Mister was also arrested from near Tarari pool, Daudnagar.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the

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petitioner that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case. The alleged arms and ammunition have not been recovered from the personal possession of the petitioner, rather the same has been recovered from the house of co-accused Md. Danish. Petitioner has no concern either with the recovered arms or with the co-accused Md. Danish. Petitioner is having one criminal antecedent vide Town P.S. Case No. 90/2026 registered u/s 103(1), 61(2), 3(5) of BNS. It is lastly submitted that co-accused Farhan Khan has been granted bail by the Hon'ble Patna High Court vide Cr. Misc. No. 37802 of 2026 and the petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody since dated 09.03.2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be released on bail.

Per contra, the learned P.P. vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

There are recoveries of arms and ammunition from the house of co-accused Danish Alam. Petitioner has been made an accused on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Danish Alam. In the present case, the petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody since dated 09.03.2026. Co-accused Farhan Khan has already been released on bail by the order of Hon'ble High Court passed in Cr. Misc. No. 37802 of 2026. Save and except the confessional statement of the co-accused, no material has been available against this petitioner and so far as recoveries of arms and ammunition are concerned, it is recovered from the house of co-accused Danish Alam.

Hence, after going through the aforesaid observation, **the bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner Md. Ragib is hereby allowed.** It is directed to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount.
