The petitioner, who has been undergoing judicial custody since dated 22.04.2026, preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Aurangabad (Mufassil) P.S. Case No.324/2025 instituted for the offence u/s 303(2), 3(5) of BNS. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the Id. P.P. for the State.

The brief facts of the prosecution is that the the informant is working as a field staff in Chaitanya India Free Credit Private Limited branch Rafiganj. On dated 29.08.2025 like everyday, he had come to village Khairamirza for collection. After completing the collection, he was returning to Rafiganj. When he reached Rediya More, he parked his motorcycle on the roadside along with the bag and went to urinate. In the meantime, three persons came and fled away with the bag kept on the motorcycle, which contained the collected amount of Rs. 82,170/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further stated that petitioner is a student. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is having five criminal antecedents vide Rafiganj P.S case no.455/2025, Rafiganj P.S case no. 254/2025, Amba P.S case no.83/2025, Amba P.S case no. 131/2025 and Kutumba P.S case no.83/2025. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody since

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dated 22.04.2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be released on bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

The present FIR has been registered against unknown persons u/s 303(2) r/w Section 3(5) of BNS. During course of investigation, it is mentioned at para 62 of the case diary that there was confessional statement given by the petitioner who was arrested in Rafiganj P.S case no. 455/2025 and he had confessed his involvement in the present case before the I.O. of Rafiganj P.S case no. 455/2025. On the basis of his confessional statement, he has been made an accused in the present case. On dated 22.04.2026 the petitioner has been remanded in the present case. On an earlier occasion, the bail petition of the petitioner was rejected by this Court on dated 21.05.2026 vide BP No.570/2026 with an observation to renew his prayer for bail after completion of investigation. Now, the investigation of this case is completed and charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioner on dated 19.05.2026. It is mentioned at para 3 of the bail petition that the petitioner is having five criminal antecedents. The petitioner has been undergoing judicial custody since dated 22.04.2026.

Considering the aforesaid observations, the bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner is hereby **allowed**. It is directed to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, subject to condition that one of the bailor shall be the parents of petitioner and if the petitioner is found to be involved in similar kind of offence in future, the state shall have liberty to move for cancellation of bail.
