The petitioner, who has been undergoing judicial custody since dated 07.05.2026, preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Deokund P.S. Case No.67/2025 instituted for the offence u/s 310(2) of BNS. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The briefly stated prosecution story is that on dated 30.11.2025 at about 11:30 p.m. ten unknown persons had looted a Pulsar Motorcycle of Informant, I-phone from Prince Kumar, Realme mobile phone from Abhijit Kumar and one samsung mobile phone from Raviranjana Kumar. It is further alleged that the miscreants had assaulted them by iron rod and danda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further stated that nothing has been recovered from the possession of informant. Petitioner was implicated only on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Ankur Kumar and Rishu Kumar. Petitioner is having two criminal antecedent vide Deokund P.S case no.18/2026 and Deokund P.S case no.23/2026. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody since dated 07.05.2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be released on bail.

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On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

The name of the petitioner has been implicated in the present case on the basis of confessional statement given by one co-accused Ankur Kumar, who was found to be using the mobile which was looted from the informant and his friend. On an earlier occasion, the bail petition of the petitioner was rejected by this Court on dated 15.06.2026 vide BP No.687/2026 with an observation to renew his prayer for bail after submission of charge-sheet. Now, the investigation of this case is completed and charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioner on dated 22.06.2026. It is mentioned at para 3 of the bail petition that petitioner is having two criminal antecedent. Petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody since dated 07.05.2026.

Considering the aforesaid observations, the bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner is hereby **allowed**. It is directed to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount.
