The petitioner, who has been undergoing judicial custody since dated 30.06.2026, preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Barun P.S. Case No.256/2026 instituted for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 109 of BNS. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the Id. P.P. for the State.

The briefly stated prosecution story is that on dated 27.06.2026, all the accused persons, including the petitioner, allegedly assaulted the informant. It is alleged that the co-accused, Naval Kishore Singh, caught hold of the informant, threw him on the ground, climbed over his chest, and pressed him with his both legs. It is further alleged that the petitioner had assaulted the informant with an iron rod in which he sustained head injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further stated that there is a land dispute going on between the parties. Petitioner is having no criminal antecedent. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody since dated 30.06.2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to voluntarily deposit Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand) in the office of Nazarat,

Aurangabad for the purpose of well-being of children residing at Vrihad Ashray Grih Balgrih Unit-I, Babhandi, Aurangabad, Bihar.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

It is alleged against the petitioner that he had caused head injury to the informant by iron rod. From perusal of case diary it is mentioned at para 13 and 14 which are statement of independent witnesses who stated before the I.O. that the informant had exaggerated the facts. Neither the petitioner nor his father was in drunken condition. The informant had sustained two injuries, one is lacerated wound on left temporal region which is found to be simple in nature and next one is chest pain and the nature of injury is kept reserved. The petitioner has been undergoing judicial custody since dated 30.06.2026. It is mentioned at para 3 of the bail petition that petitioner is having no criminal antecedent.

Considering the fact that injury caused over the vital part of the body of informant is found to be simple in nature and the injury which has been caused over non-vital part of the body of informant, has been kept reserved. Apart from the aforesaid facts, the petitioner is having clean antecedent. Hence, the bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner is hereby **allowed**. It is directed to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount.

Since the petitioner is ready to voluntarily deposit Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand) **in the office of Nazarat, Aurangabad** for the purpose of well-being of children residing at Vrihad Ashray Grih Balgrih Unit-I, Babhandi, Aurangabad, Bihar. Hence, the petitioner is permitted to deposit the same.
