The petitioners, who have been undergoing judicial custody since dated 30.06.2026, preferred this application for grant of bail in connection with Aurangabad (Town) P.S. Case No. 422/2026 instituted for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 329(3), 329(4), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the Id. P.P. for the State.

The briefly stated prosecution story is that Rampukar Yadav, his son Kunal Kumar and his wife had brutally assaulted the informant Babita Devi and his son Kunal Kumar Singh by iron rod, knife, lathi, danda and hockey stick as a result of which the informant had sustained injury over her head while the son of informant had received injury over his hand.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. The present case is the counter blast of Muffasil P.S. Case No. 299/2026. No specific allegation has been attributed against the petitioners. All other sections are bailable in nature except Sections 109(1) of BNS which has been levelled only to make the case non-bailable. Petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. It is lastly submitted that the petitioners have been languishing under judicial custody since dated 30.06.2026. On these grounds, it is prayed that the petitioners be enlarged on bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. opposed the prayer for bail of the

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petitioners.

Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and learned P.P. for the State.

It is alleged against the petitioners that they had caused head injury to the informant Babita Devi and fracture of hand to his son Kunal Kumar Singh. On today, during course of hearing, the State has supplied injury report. From perusal of the same, it is found that the son of informant Kunal Kumar Singh had received injury, which is found to be simple in nature. From perusal of injury report of Babita Devi, it is mentioned that she was advised for NCCT brain but till now, the opinion regarding nature of injury has not been given as it is kept reserved. Petitioners are having clean antecedent and have been languishing under judicial custody in the present case since dated 30.06.2026.

Considering the aforesaid observation, **the bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners Rampukar Yadav @ Kaushal Kumar Himanshu and Kunal Kumar is hereby allowed.** It is directed to release the petitioners on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount by each.
