The petitioner, who has been undergoing judicial custody since dated 03.07.2026, preferred this application for grant of bail in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 660 of 2026 instituted under Sections 20(b), 22 and 25 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1885. A copy of the bail petition has been served upon the learned P.P. for the State.

As per prosecution case, on dated 28.02.2026 at about 08:10 p.m., during course of vehicle checking, a motorcycle was intercepted. Petitioner was riding the motorcycle bearing Registration No. BR 26AD 4066 and from his possession 0.392 kg ganja recovered found kept in a plastic bag.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that seizure list does not contain either the name or the signature of any independent witness and all are police personnel. Sections imposed against the petitioner are not attracted. Petitioner is having no criminal antecedent. It is lastly submitted that petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody since dated 03.07.2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be given the privilege of bail.

On the other hand, learned Special P.P. opposed the prayer for grant of bail of the petitioner.

There is allegation that the petitioner was arrested with 0.392 kg ganja. On the basis of the aforesaid allegation, the petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody since dated 03.07.2026. It is mentioned at para-3 of the bail petition that the petitioner is having no criminal antecedent.

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Considering the quantity of recovered ganja, which is small quantity and the petitioner has been languishing under judicial custody in the present case since dated 03.07.2026. Apart from the aforesaid fact, the petitioner is having clean antecedent. **Hence, the bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner Niraj Kumar is hereby allowed.** It is directed to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount.
