Apprehending their arrest in connection with Daudnagar P.S. Case No.677/2021 instituted for the offences u/s 147, 149, 341, 323, 308, 427, 379, 354, 504 of Indian Penal Code, petitioners have moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the ld. P.P. for the State.

The briefly stated prosecution story is that on dated 31.12.2021 at about 02:00 PM all the accused persons including the petitioners had abused to the informant and his wife. It is further alleged that Abhay Kumar had assaulted the informant, causing head injury. It is further alleged that accused persons have broken the bike of informant. Subham Kumar had taken away a mobile of informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further stated that there is a counter FIR vide Daudnagar P.S Case no.678/2021. Petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be

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enlarged on anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned P.P. for the State.

It is alleged against the petitioner no.1 that he had given order to other co-accused persons to kill the informant. There is specific allegation against co-accused Abhay Kumar, who is not the petitioner in this case that he had caused head injury to informant by katta (dab). Further an allegation against petitioner no.4 and petitioner no.5 that they had entered into scuffle with the wife of informant with ill motive. Thereafter, all the accused persons had damaged bike causing wrongful loss to an amount of Rs.84,000/- The present case is an old one. The present FIR was registered on dated 31.12.2021. There is a counter FIR vide Daudnagar P.S case no.678/2021. It is mentioned at para 89 of the case diary that petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. So far as injury details are concerned, Tunu Choudhary had received injury which is found to be simple in nature and his wife had received injury which is also found to be simple in nature.

Considering the aforesaid observations, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners is hereby **allowed**. It is directed to release the above-named petitioners on bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
