Apprehending his arrest in connection with Aurangabad (Muffasil) P.S. Case No. 234/2026 instituted under Section 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 303(2), 74 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioner has moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon Ld. P.P. for the state.

The brief facts of the case are that the petitioner had abused and beaten to the husband of informant and caused injury over his head by lathi. When the informant came for his rescue, the petitioner had torn her clothes and snatched a golden chain.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. Nothing has been happened as alleged by the informant and total case is false and fabricated. All other sections are bailable in nature except Section 303(2) and 74 of BNS. The present case is the counter blast of Muffasil P.S. Case No. 222/2026. Petitioner is having no criminal antecedent. On these grounds, it is prayed that the petitioner be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, learned P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

As per allegation, the petitioner had beaten to the husband of informant Pradip Singh and thereafter, abused and caught hold to the informant by her hair. The petitioner further snatcher her golden chain and torn her clothes. The

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aforesaid incident was taken place on dated 17.05.2026 but the FIR was lodged in the present case on dated 21.5.2026 without any explanation of delay. The present FIR has been registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 303(2), 74 of BNS. So far as allegation u/s 303(2) is concerned, it appears to be ornamental in nature and the FIR has been lodged much belatedly. It is mentioned at para-3 of the anticipatory bail petition that the petitioner is having no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid observation, **the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner Amit Singh @ Amit Kumar Singh is hereby allowed.** It is directed to release the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount subject to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
