Apprehending his arrest in connection with Aurangabad (Muffasil) P.S. Case No. 244 of 2026 instituted under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 318(4), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, petitioner has moved before this court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail. A copy of the anticipatory bail petition has been served upon the Id. P.P. for the State.

The brief facts of the case are that the brother of the informant had constructed house over the land of informant. On objection being raised, his brother, Kamlesh Ram, elder sister-in-law Kamla Devi and nephew Sandip Ram had abused and threatened to kill him by gun. It is further alleged that on dated 25.05.2026, the accused persons had abused and assaulted the informant and Sandip Kumar had threatened the informant at the point of gun.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing has been happened as alleged in the FIR. There is land dispute between the parties. The present case is purely civil in nature. Petitioner is having one criminal antecedent vide Muffasil P.S. Case No. 214/2018 in which he is on bail. Co-accused persons have been released on anticipatory bail by this court vide A.B.P. No. 1568/2026. It is therefore prayed that the petitioner be released on anticipatory bail.

Per contra, learned P.P. opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.

There is specific allegation against the petitioner that he had

threatened to the informant and his wife by a country made gun. There is admitted position that land dispute is going on between the parties. Petitioner is having one criminal antecedent vide Muffasil P.S. Case No. 214/2018. So far as allegations are concerned, the aforesaid incident was happened on dated 25.05.2026 but the FIR regarding the same was lodged on dated 01.06.2026. Other co-accused persons have been released on anticipatory bail vide A.B.P. No. 1568/2026.

Considering the fact that there is delay in lodging the FIR, land dispute is going on between the parties and co-accused persons have been released on anticipatory bail. **Hence, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner Sandeep Ram @ Sandeep Kumar Ram is hereby allowed.** It is directed to release the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court below and the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
