The learned counsel for the applicant/accused in custody since 10.09.2023 has filed a bail petition for provisional bail, after serving the copy of such petition to the learned counsel for the Special Public Prosecutor (NDPS) showing the ill health of the petitioner/accused Ajit Rai.

Heard.

The learned counsel has submitted that the petitioner is confronting with the severe ailment and the proper treatment is not being extended to the petitioner/accused in jail and has prayed to extend the provisional bail to the applicant/accused considering the issue revolving around the petitioner as such.

At the other hand the learned Special Public Prosecutor has submitted that the regular bail applications of the accused/petitioner has already been refused by this court and by the Hon'ble Patna High Court by order dated 23.08.2024 as passed in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 23159 of 2024 and no any other bail applications so far preferred by him before to the Hon'ble Patna High Court thereafter. Showing the enormity of offence and rejection of bail even from the higher Court it has been prayed that such prayer may not be entertained in the interest of justice.

After cogitating over the contents so raised on behalf of the parties, it appers from the perusal of the case record, the matter relating to these very accused/petitioner is pending at the stage of prosecution evidence and the trial is in full swing. Many of the witnesses have been examined in the matter and the accused/petitioner is facing the serious allegation of recovery of the contraband in the matter and it is also true as stated by the prosecution that the regular bail of the accused/petitioner has been rejected by this court and by the Hon'ble Patna High Court as well. In such state of the facts, the regular bail application cannot be entertained bearing in mind the judicial discipline as such it is **refused**. But it is also hereby ordered that the office may communicate to the Jail Superintendent, Daudnagar through the Jail Superintendent Aurangabad for the best medical treatment be made available to the accused/petitioner in order to ensure speedy recuperation of the accused in jail. Accordingly, the petition is **disposed off**.
