This is an application filed on behalf of A-2/ P.V. Kulkarni seeking permission to carry new spectacles and religious books, received from Bail & Filing Section, RADC, New Delhi.

Present: Sh. V.K. Pathak, Ld. Sr. PP for the CBI along with Mr. B.P. Raju, ASP/ EO-III/New Delhi.

Mr. Hemant Shah, Mr. Karan Mann, Mr. Akash Chauhan, Mr. Vishal Mann and Mr. Nikhil, Ld. Counsels for A-2.

1. Heard. Perused.
2. Copy of the application has been supplied to Ld. Sr. PP for CBI.
3. Heard submissions made by Ld. Counsel for the accused as well as by Ld. Sr. PP.
4. Ld. Counsel for the accused submits that the accused is presently lodged in Central Jail No.7, Tihar Jail Complex and that he was allowed to carry his spectacles at the time he was first remanded to Judicial custody. Ld. Counsel further submits that A-2 has informed his family members that he is having trouble and irritation in his eyes due to the

old spectacles and he requires a new spectacles so that he can carry out his day to day activities more comfortably.

5. Ld. counsel further submits that A-2 may also be allowed with religious books during his custody, as detailed in para 6 of the application. Thus, it is prayed that directions for providing the spectacles as well as religious books to the accused be issued to Jail Authorities.

6. Ld. Sr. PP submits that the requests of the accused may be considered as per Jail Manual/ Rules.

7. Considering the entire facts & circumstances of the instant case and the submissions made on behalf of A-2, concerned Jail Authorities are directed to provide spectacles to the accused which shall be supplied by any of his family member/ his authorized counsel subject to the prevalent rules of Jail Manual.

8. Further, concerned Jail Authorities are also directed to provide the religious books to the accused as mentioned in para 6 of the application which shall be supplied by any of his family member/ his authorized counsel to the Jail Authorities.

8.1. After receipt of said books and prior to their delivery to the accused, the same shall be subject to the security check by the Jail Authorities as per Jail Manual or relevant

rules in this regard and if any content/ book deemed objectionable, explicit or a security risk will be confiscated.

8.2. The accused shall abide by all the rules & guidelines, as laid down in Jail Manual regarding provision of retaining books in jail.

8.3. The concerned Jail Superintendent is directed to allow the accused to retain the provided books as per prevalent rules qua the same inside the jail premises subject to security check.

9. The application stands disposed off in the aforesaid terms. Copy of this order as well as application of A-2 be sent to Jail Authorities concerned for information and necessary compliance.

10. Copy of order be given Dasti.
