

COMMITTAL ORDER

The accused is present . He is charged with the offence which is exclusively triable by the Court of Session. The copies of police report and other documents as specified in section 207 (or section 208) of the Code of Criminal Procedure have been supplied to the accused. The case will have to be committed to the Court of Session. Hence the order:-

1. The case be committed to the Court of Session.
2. The accused is directed to appear before the Court of Session on
3. The record of the case, the documents and articles, which are to be produced in evidence, shall be sent to the Court of Session.
4. The police Station Officer, HASPURA be directed to produce muddemal property in the Court of Session on or before positively.
5. The Public Prosecutor shall be notified of the commitment of the case to the Court of Session.
