ORDER

1. *Apprehending arrest the petitioners have preferred this pre-arrest bail application who are booked in Amarpur Police Station Case No. 871 of 2025, for the offence allegedly committed under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 74, 352, 351(2), 3/5 of BNS.*

2. *The case of prosecution is engendered upon a gravamen filed by one Buttan Paswan with the allegations that on 04.12.2025, at about 03:00 pm, his daughter Tulsi Kumari, aged about 12 years went to take water from old house; (i). Rajesh Paswan, (ii). Neeraj Paswan, both molested his daughter. When his daughter yelled, he came and tried to make them understand upon which they started abusing. When he refused them to use cuss language, then (iii) Buddhi Paswan, (iv). Shekhar Paswan, (v). Subodh Paswan, came there and with intent to kill they all assaulted with iron rod, blackjack and stick etc., resultantly his head ruptured and blood started oozing. Upon yelling, his wife Rakha Devi, and Kundan Paswan and daughter-in-law Anjali Devi came, then they too were attacked by them. Then, Pramod Paswan and son of Pramod Paswan also came and abused*

them.

3. *In oral arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that there are omnibus allegations and there is no serious issue inter se parties. It is argued that the squabble took place on both sides.*

4. *In counter, learned Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the pre-arrest bail application and drew attention on the injury reports according to which Buttan Paswan sustained sharp cutting wound over left forehead of 03CM x 1/4 cm x scalp depth.*

5. *Heard submissions and perused the record. There are specific allegations against the present petitioners for assaulting with iron rod, etc. The injury report of Buttan Paswan is corroborated with the allegations leveled against them, therefore, keeping in view the above, this court is not inclined to grant the privilege of pre-arrest bail; resultantly, this pre-arrest bail application is dismissed.*

6. *File be consigned to the record room and that of trial court be sent back with a copy of this order.*

7. *Keeping in view the General Order no. 1 of 1991 (Criminal) dated 07.03.1991, the certified copy of FIR, if desired, be returned back to the petitioners on placing the xerox copy thereof on record.*
