Dablu Kumar Sah vs State of Bihar.

12.06.2020

A surrender cum bail petition is filed on behalf of the accused Dablu Kumar Sah, in connection with Excise Comp. case no.-15/2020 under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

The case of the prosecution in short is that on 22.02.2020 at about 08:00 pm the excise police was checking vehicle in the meantime one white coloured Kwid car bearing registration number BR 10PB3344 was coming from bhaljor side, that the police stopped the car but instead of stop the driver of the car rushed the car with great speed. That on suspicion the police chased the car but the driver and other managed to escape after parking the car. That on search of car some paper regarding owner of the car namely Dablu Kumar Sah was recovered and also altogether 17.925litres of illicit liquor was recovered from the aforesaid car.

Heard the learned Defence counsel as well as the learned Spl.P.P. for the State.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and is falsely implicated in this case. It is further stated that the petitioner is only the registered owner of the seized car and he has nothing to do with the seized liquor and this petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

On the other hand, Learned Spl. P.P. opposed the bail petition.

In the facts and circumstances of the case and also keeping in mind the amount of seizure made by the police, this bail application is allowed on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 with two suerities of like amount.
