ORDER

1. Apprehending arrest the petitioners have preferred this pre-arrest bail application who are booked in Banka (Odani Dam) Police Station Case No. 82 of 2026, for the offence allegedly committed under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 3/5 of BNS.

2. The case of prosecution is based upon a gravamen filed by one Vishnath Yadav with the allegations that on 08.12.2026, at about 09:00 pm, (i). Babulal Yadav, (ii). Ramrup Yadav, (iii). Karmi Devi, (iv). Chandani Devi, (v). Pintu Yadav, (vi). Ramjivan Yadav, in collusion with each other, attacked his family due to some previous dispute. Ramrup Yadav attacked with axe and blackjack, resultantly the head of Rajesh Yadav ruptured and blood started oozing. His brother Nageshwar Yadav was assaulted by Pintu Yadav with stick and blackjack, resultantly he sustained multiple injuries.

3. In oral arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that no one is injured in this trivial squabble and the injuries as alleged are not corroborated inter se complaint and injury reports.

4. In counter, learned Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the pre-arrest bail application and drew attention of the Court on injury reports of Rajesh

Yadav and Nageshwar Yadav, which shows no bony fracture.

5. *Heard submissions and perused the record. Without more commenting on merits of this case, after taking into consideration the fact that the gravamen as well as injury reports do not corroborate each other, this court is inclined to grant the petitioners privilege of pre-arrest bail. It is, therefore, ordered that upon arrest or surrender of the petitioners within fortnight of receiving the instant order the petitioners be admitted to anticipatory bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of trial court subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. Out of the two sureties, one will be of the same village or close relative of petitioners.*

6. *File be consigned to the record room and that of trial court be sent back with a copy of this order.*

7. *Keeping in view the General Order no. 1 of 1991 (Criminal) dated 07.03.1991, the certified copy of FIR, if desired, be returned back to the petitioners on placing the xerox copy thereof on record.*
