- 1. Apprehending arrest the petitioners have preferred this pre-arrest bail application who are booked in Dhoraiya Police Station Case No. 54 of 2026, for the offence allegedly committed under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 115(2), 118(1), 352, 351(2), 303(2), 109(1), 190 of BNS.*
- 2. The case of prosecution is based upon a gravamen filed by one Arun*

Kumar Singh with the allegations that on 09.02.2026, when he was irrigating his field, his co-villagers (i). Parmanand Singh, (ii). Navneet Singh, (iii). Amit Singh, (iv). Nitish Kumar Singh, (v). Vikki Kumar Singh, (vi). Nitish Chouhan, (vi). Anita Devi, (vii). Laxmi Devi, (ix). Soni Devi armed with iron rod, Khanti, blackjack etc. came there and Parmanand Singh said that he is the person who has reported the police and provoked to kill upon which Parmanand Singh with intent to kill him gave a blow of sharp edged Dabiya on his head, resultantly his head ruptured and his ear was also cut. Upon yelling, his wife Rukmani Devi, daughter Laxmi Devi, and brother Arbind Kumar came there, then they were also assaulted and injured. Accused Parmanand Singh with bad intention molested his wife Rukmani Devi and when she tried to save herself, Parmanand Singh gave a blow of Dabiya on her ear, resultantly her ear was also injured. Nitish Chouhan assaulted Arbind Singh with the butt of three-nut, resultantly he was also injured. In the meantime, (x). Gopal Singh, (xi). Shambho Singh, (xii). Puja Devi came there and they started beating with leg, fists etc. to Rukmani Devi and Laxmi Devi. Anita Devi snatched gold earring from Rukmani Devi. Soni Devi snatched silver necklace from Laxmi Kumari.

3. *In oral arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that they have falsely been implicated in this case, whereas no injury is corroborated to the allegations in the gravamen. It is further argued that both parties have arrived at compromise.*

4. *In counter, learned Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the pre-arrest bail application.*

5. *Heard submissions and perused the record. The record reveals that in para no. 16 of the case diary, it is injury report of Arun Kumar Singh, who has sustained no bony parenchymal lesion. Likewise, injury report of Rukmani Devi who has sustained no bony parenchymal lesion and injury report of Laxmi Kumari, who has sustained no bony parenchymal lesion. Keeping in view the above, this court is inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioners. It is, therefore, ordered that upon arrest or surrender of the petitioners within fortnight*

of receiving the instant order the petitioners be admitted to anticipatory bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of trial court subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. Out of the two sureties, one will be of the same village or close relative of petitioners.

6. *File be consigned to the record room and that of trial court be sent back with a copy of this order.*

7. *Keeping in view the General Order no. 1 of 1991 (Criminal) dated 07.03.1991, the certified copy of FIR, if desired, be returned back to the petitioners on placing the xerox copy thereof on record.*
