ORDER

1. *Apprehending arrest the petitioners have preferred this pre-arrest bail application who are booked in Amarpur Police Station Case No. 35 of 2026, for the offence allegedly committed under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3/5 of BNS.*

2. *The case of prosecution is engendered upon an application filed by one Kapildeo Yadav with the allegations that on 16.01.2026, at about 07:00 am, accused persons namely, i. Bijali Yadav, ii. Bambam Kumar, iii. Nitesh Kumar, iv. Prity Kumari, v. Ludho Devi were there. A bull came before his buffalo. He tried to drove away upon which Bijali Yadav started abusing. When he refused to do so, then Bijali Yadav and Bambam Kumar with intent to kill him ruptured his head with iron khanti. Upon hearing of yelling, his son Bittu Kumar came to rescue, then Ludho Devi and Nitesh Kumar attacked with blackjack and stick on his head and Prity Kumari snatched gold chain from his neck.*

3. *In oral arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that they have falsely been implicated in this case whereas they have not connection or nexus of any kind with alleged crime.*

4. *In counter, learned Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the pre-arrest bail application on the ground that there are direct allegations of assault with*

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Khanti, blackjack and stick. He drew attention of the court on para no. 6 of the case diary, which is injury report, wherein it is reported that injured Kapildev Yadav sustained lacerated wound of size 4" x 1/2" x 1/2" over mid region of frontal head.

5. *Heard rival submissions and perused the record. Keeping in view the nature of allegations as well as injury report, this court is not inclined to grant the petitioners privilege of pre-arrest bail; resultantly, this pre-arrest bail application is dismissed.*

6. *File be consigned to the record room and that of trial court be sent back with a copy of this order.*

7. *Keeping in view the General Order no. 1 of 1991 (Criminal) dated 07.03.1991, the certified copy of FIR, if desired, be returned back to the petitioners on placing the xerox copy thereof on record.*
