ORDER

1. *Yearning for an order of emancipation the petition has been filed by the petitioner, who is booked in Rajoun Police Station Case No. 619 of 2024, for the offence allegedly committed under Sections 308(2), 352, 351(2), 3/5 of BNS and is confined in jail since 27.01.2026.*

2. *The case of prosecution is engendered upon a gravamen filed by one Dayanand Yadav with the allegation that in the night of 28.12.2024, he was going to sleep. At about 10:00 pm, 1. Kaju Yadav, 2. Bablu Yadav, 3. Arbind Yadav, 4. Sourav Kumar, they all in collusion with each other came there and started abusing. When he peeped of the window, all of them stood in front of his house and were shouting to come out of the house and they fired. He did not come out of the house. The denizens came there upon which they left the place by threatening to give Rs. 1 lakh as extortion, otherwise he will be killed.*

3. *In oral arguments, the learned counsel for petitioner submitted that he has falsely been implicated in this case for party politics. It is further submitted that there is no delivery of money in this case. It is further submitted that the accused/petitioner is confined in jail since 27.01.2026. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent.*

4. *In counter, learned Public Prosecutor for the State stoutly opposed the bail application on the ground that the bail applications of other co-accused have been rejected by this court.*

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5. *Heard rival submissions and perused the record. The record reveals that co-accused Bablu Yadav has been granted bail by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Patna vide Criminal Misc. no. 18703 of 2026, who was having 13 criminal antecedents of similar nature. The case of present petitioner is on lessor footings, as he is having only one criminal history that too under sections 85, 82 (1), 115 (2), 351 (2) (3), 352 (3) (5) of the BNS. Therefore, the present petitioner is ordered to be emancipated on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of trial court. Out of the two sureties, one will be of the same village or close relative of petitioner.*

6. *File be consigned to the record room and that of trial court be sent back with a copy of this order.*

7. *Keeping in view the General Order no. 1 of 1991 (Criminal) dated 07.03.1991, the certified copy of FIR, if desired, be returned back to the petitioner on placing the xerox copy thereof on record.*
