ORDER

- 1. Apprehending arrest the petitioners have preferred this pre-arrest bail application who are booked in Amarpur Police Station Case No. 838 of 2025, for the offence allegedly committed under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 74, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3/5 of BNS.*
- 2. The case of prosecution is engendered upon an application filed by one Viveka Singh with the allegations that on 19.11.2025, at about 09:00 am, (i). Sitaram Singh, (ii). Bablu Singh, (iii). Nigam Singh, (iv). Digam Singh, (v). Ranjit Singh, (vi). Rahul Singh, (vii). Abhishek Singh, (viii). Karuna Devi, (ix). Gita Devi, (x). Gunjan Devi, (xi). Sushma Devi came and started abusing. When they were refused, they used cuss language and assaulted the informant with blackjack, sticks etc. and they injured them. Rahul Singh with intent to kill, assaulted on the head of his son and other family members.*
- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner in his oral arguments, submitted that there are general and omnibus allegations. There is no specific overt act attributed to the present petitioner. It is further submitted that there is no criminal antecedent. It is submitted that there is delay of 5 days in lodging the FIR from the date of alleged incident.*
- 4. In counter, learned public prosecutor stoutly opposed the bail application on the ground that the pre-arrest bail application of other accused persons has already been rejected by this court vide ABP No. 1680 of 2025.*
- 5. Heard rival submissions and perused the record. Keeping in view the fact*

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that the injured person sustained injury on their head i.e. a vital part of the body, hence, without more commenting on the merits of this case, this court is not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioner; resultantly it is dismissed.

6. *File be consigned to the record room and that of trial court be sent back with a copy of this order.*

7. *Keeping in view the General Order no. 1 of 1991 (Criminal) dated 07.03.1991, the certified copy of FIR, if desired, be returned back to the petitioners on placing the xerox copy thereof on record.*
