	<u>15.04.2026</u>	A petition is filed on behalf of the accused namely 1) Chhotu Yadav, who is in custody since 26.03.2026, in connection with Banka Excise P.S. Case no.- 132/2026 under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016. The case of the prosecution in short is that on 25.03.2026 at about 2:40 PM, informant along with other police officials was checking vehicles & breath analyser test at Bhaljor Checkpost and in that process they stopped a passenger bus. In the meantime, one person carrying a blure colored plastic bag tried to escape. However, police chased and nabbed him. On enquiry, he told his name as 1) Chhotu Yadav. On search of said bag altogether 6 litres of illicit foreign made liquor were recovered. Heard the learned Defence counsel as well as the learned Spl.P.P. for the State. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and is falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty politics of the village & locality. It is further stated that petitioner has no concerned with seized liquor. It is also stated that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Accused in custody since 26.03.2026 & there is no criminal history against the petitioner. So, he may be released on bail On the other hand, Learned Spl. P.P. Smt. Shobha Kumari opposed the bail petition. Heard both the parties, I have perused the case record and seizure list available on record. It appears that there is no criminal antecedent against the accused, which is mentioned in para 9 of case diary. Accused is in custody since 26.03.2026. After considering the facts & circumstances of the present case, recovery of low amount of foreign made liquor & detention period, present bail application of the accused is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount.
