	<u>23.04.2026</u>	A petition is filed on behalf of the accused namely 1) Ramesh Kisku, who is in custody since 15.04.2026, in connection with Anandpur P.S. Case no.- 35/2026 under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016. The case of the prosecution in short is that on 13.04.2026 at about 10:10 PM, after getting a secret information, informant along with other police officials went at the house of Ramesh Kisku at village- Dudhikura. In the meantime, after seeing the police party, all family member of the said house successfully managed to escape. On search of said house altogether 10 litres of illicit country made liquor were recovered. Heard the learned Defence counsel as well as the learned Spl.P.P. for the State. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and is falsely been implicated in this case due to local politics. It is further stated that the allegations brought against the petitioner is totally false and fabricated. It is also stated that the petitioner has no concerned with the said recovered articles. Accused in custody since 15.04.2026. So, she may be released on bail On the other hand, Learned Spl. P.P. Smt. Shobha Kumari opposed the bail petition. Heard both the parties, I have perused the case record and seizure list available on record. It appears that altogether 10 litres of illicit country made liquor were recovered from the petitioner's house. Accused is in custody since 15.04.2026. After considering the aforementioned facts & circumstances of the present case, recovery of low amount of country made liquor & detention period, present bail application of the accused is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount.
